Midwestern University is a private, not-for-profit graduate degree-granting institution specializing in the health sciences with 14 colleges and two campuses.



- The Downers Grove Campus was purchased in 1986, and the Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine moved from its prior home in Hyde Park, Illinois, to this western suburb of Illinois.
- MWU's faculty mix reflects a blend of experienced teachers, prominent scientists, and established clinicians.
- The University is accredited by The Higher Learning Commission, a Commission of the North Central Association (NCA) of Colleges and Schools

One Health Initiative

Midwestern University is committed to the principles of One Health, which fosters interdisciplinary cooperation between various human and veterinary medical specialties to fight disease, improve research and knowledge, and provide more complete care for all patients. Healthcare Impact: Midwestern University boasts more than 20,000 alumni who are working in leading hospitals, pharmacies, private practices, governmental agencies, academic institutions, and healthcare facilities.



Economic Impact: According to a survey by Applied Economics, the University has an economic impact of \$439 million in DuPage County, driven by University operations, local vendor purchases, spending by employees and students, and campus visitors. The University also supports over 1,100 jobs.



Environmental Impact: The University occupies a 105-acre campus in Downers Grove, Illinois and received a U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Chicago Wilderness Conservation and Native Landscaping Award for the restoration of 8.97 acres of wetlands and oak-hickory woods.

Community Service: The University is committed to community service in Illinois. Midwestern students and employees provide nearly 21,000 hours of community service each year by participating in a wide variety of outreach programs, health screenings, and health education programs throughout the state.

At the Midwestern University Multispecialty Clinic, state-of-the-art community healthcare is provided by licensed faculty and advanced students, with more than 67,000 patient visits each year.
