



VVMC Resident Roshini Pradeep MD got Accepted for Fellowship Training at Banner MD Anderson



Upon completing her three-year residency in Internal Medicine at VVMC, Dr. Roshini Pradeep will head to University of Arizona Banner MD Anderson Cancer Center in Phoenix for a prestigious + fellowship in Hematology Oncology.

While in the IM Residency program, directed by Dr. Neychelle Rocca, Dr. Pradeep conducted

numerous research projects and quality improvement initiatives in collaboration with NAH staff and

faculty, all while learning how to be a doctor seeing patients in-house at VVMC and in the outpatient +

Continuity Clinic. She also served a rotation at the University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center

in Houston, in which she made valuable contacts and partnered in an abstract published in the

American Society of Hematology's journal, Blood (see attached). She credits her experience there

with helping her build her resume and research portfolio.


Dr. Pradeep's other published research and scholarly activities included a root-cause analysis of readmission, the effects of proton-pump inhibitors on patients with colitis, and possible links between malnutrition and cancer treatment, as well as numerous case studies including one that explored the health disparities of women with breast cancer in rural communities.

Dr. Pradeep's long-term career goals are to be involved in academic medical settings and continue to engage in clinical research. The VVMC Residency Program is very proud of the many accomplishments of Dr. Pradeep and we wish her the best as she continues to develop into a fantastic physician.

We are delighted to announce that **Dr. Kunal Deora**, Internal Medicine Resident at Verde Valley Medical Center, was selected as a **finalist** and successfully presented his **clinical vignette** at the **American College of Physicians (ACP) National Resident/Fellow Poster Competition** during the Internal Medicine Meeting 2025 in New Orleans, Louisiana.

The vignette, titled "A First Reported Case of Evans Syndrome Associated with Hereditary Hemochromatosis: Exploring Immune Dysregulation," was selected by the ACP Abstract Review Board for its rare presentation and strong clinical insight. The project was a collaborative effort involving fellow residents Dr. Jugraj Singh, Dr. Shrenil Kavathia, and Dr. Mansha Gupta, under the guidance and mentorship of **Program Director Dr. Rocca**.

Dr. Deora presented the case on April 4, 2025, at the Ernest N. Morial Convention Center, representing VVMC among top residents from across the country. We are proud of our team's dedication to academic medicine and commend their contribution in placing + VVMC on a national stage for clinical excellence.
